Pricing for a Home

I'm making sure I keep my pricing for an evaluation down.

Pricing is based on size of your home. We start at **\$200** for a home that is 1400 square feet or less and add for every extra 100 square feet an extra \$10.

So, as an example: a home that is 2000 square, the fee is \$260. We start at \$200 and we have an extra 600 square feet. So, 6 times \$10 equals \$60. \$60 plus \$200 equals \$260. A larger home just takes longer. This price is based on the agent or homeowner following me and writing everything down.

Another example: a home of 6000 square feet costs $\$200 + (10 \times 46) = \646 .
